



Corporate Volunteer Opportunities with New Yorkers for Parks

New Yorkers for Parks (NY4P) is the citywide independent organization championing quality parks and open spaces for all New Yorkers in all neighborhoods.

Founded in 2001 to commemorate September 11, **The Daffodil Project** began as a living memorial to raise the spirits of New Yorkers and beautify parks and communities in a time of sorrow. Today, it is one of the largest volunteer projects in the city's history, highlighting the needs of neglected parks and uniting residents, parks and civic organizations, elected officials, and businesses to become active stewards of their local green spaces. Since its inception, **40,000 volunteers** have planted more than **4.5 million daffodil bulbs** in **2,000 parks and open spaces**.

NY4P has relationships with more than 300 community parks groups, as well as public schools throughout the five boroughs, and can organize clean-ups on weekdays and weekends during the summer and planting events in the fall. **Our corporate partners are an integral participant in our efforts to clean and beautify some of the city's highest need parks.** Your project contribution not only covers necessary materials and staffing for your volunteer event, but also provides critical support to the work NY4P does in neighborhoods throughout New York City. Each volunteer day is organized by full-time NY4P staff who coordinate logistics with the Parks Department and community groups and are on-site the day of your volunteer outing, sharing a history of the park where the project is taking place and outlining the positive impacts volunteers' efforts have in the community.

Where: Various parks across New York City, specific borough to be coordinated with the corporate partner

When: Weekdays or weekends available; typically four hours

Group Size: 50 maximum

Experience: None necessary

Project Contribution: \$5,000

Lunch: NY4P can work with the corporate partner to make lunch arrangements according to the company's needs/budget.

Insurance/Liability Waivers: NY4P does not require waivers and is fully insured.
